- Complements other selection processes
- Managed by Admissions Testing



- Accepted by a range of top universities
- Accepted internationally
- Free support and prep materials
- Content internationally accessible
- Allows top takers to stand out
- Available worldwide
- Range of access arrangements
- Range of test dates*

BMAT: benefits for delivery

- Established rules and regulations
- Quicker delivery, less scope for errors
- Familiar to test centres
- More choice of centres
- More candidate capacity
- Allows malpractice checks

Delivery BMAT vs IMAT BMAT IMAT

- Not anonymous
- Taker ID verification
- Multiple locations
- Large capacity
- Dates suited to admissions cycles
- Simple process for centres and takers
- Familiar process internationally


- Anonymous
- Taker ID not guaranteed
- Limited capacity & locations
- Dates not ideal
- Complicated pre/post test admin
- Process confusing outside Italy

Results BMAT vs IMAT BMAT IMAT

- 3 scores
- No negative marking
- Used by many unis
- Can be mapped against future performance
- Multiple options for ranking takers


- Single score
- Negative marking
- Only used in Italy
- No mapping or research options
- Simple ranking of takers
